When school leaders empower teachers to create stronger bonds with their students, they build the foundation that leads to positive outcomes for students and their school community.¹



● Ask


Teachers choose from a mix of research informed questions (open-ended and scaffolded) or write one of their own to share with students. Students then respond—sharing about themselves and their classroom experience.

● Reflect

Teachers can review quick insights—students' individual responses and class-wide data—to help build more engaging classrooms.

● Act
